



### **Update to OMAA members: NDIS advocacy by OMAA - 27.6.22**

Hello OMAA Members and other interested parties.

As you are aware, the OMAA has been working collaboratively with all of the major stakeholders within the community of vision loss in order to resolve the issue of cutting the support codes for O&M services from the new NDIS 22-23 Price Guide. Here is what the OMAA received at 3pm today from, our co-stakeholder, GDA representative, Jeremy Anderson:

"I have spoken with Bill Shorten's office today and it appears we may be close to a result.

Their feedback is that they are aware it is a live issue for our sector and wanted to assure us that there won't be a cut to funding nor will people lose their supports. The Minister's office is working with the NDIA at present to ensure this is achieved and we will be updated shortly. I expect this to be today or tomorrow."
